Effective study and research skills are essential for today’s young people to give them a head start at university or work. Librarians and teachers recognise the need for these skills but it can be difficult finding the time to integrate them into the curriculum.

Divided into two sections, the first part of this training session concentrates on success in study skills for the sixth form, with suggestions for format and

lesson content. The second half examines how these ideas can be transferred to the lower secondary and upper primary years with an opportunity for delegates to discuss and share their ideas.



The session is suitable for secondary school librarians and teachers with an interest in providing study skills. Some ideas will be transferable to the primary sector.
