English

- Create and describe a scary monster
- Write a descriptive poem of a storm creating strong imagery
- Write a ghost/mystery story
- Explanatory text on how electricity works
- Recount of a frightening dream
- Biography of a famous poet

Maths

- Currency exchanging whilst travelling to different parts of the world
- Convert nine months of writing into days, hours, minutes, seconds

Science

- Identify appliances that run on electricity
- Construct simple circuits with bulbs, switches and buzzers
- Create a circuit with a switch to show how a circuit is broken
- Use circuit symbols to draw a circuit
- Materials which conduct electricity
- The water cycle, evaporation and condensation

History/Geography

- Study natural disasters around the world – volcanoes, earthquakes
- River study
- Compare Switzerland to your local area
- Climate zones
- Georgian history, timeline, main historical events

Art/DT

- Use colour effectively to create pictures that depict different moods

- Study the work of J.M.W. Turner
- Design and create a monster, adding a circuit to make his eyes light up

RE/PSHE

- Relationships – Mary’s relationship with her father and husband
- Perseverance – Mary’s determination
- Respect – what happens when we don’t feel respected
- Confidence – having the confidence to do things, even when you struggle

ICT

- Graphical representation: look at how to use shapes, grouping them and layering them to create different effects
- Use shapes to create a 2D representation of a building with many key features included e.g. Frankenstein’s Castle

Music/Dance

- Listen to Thunder and Lightening by Johann Strauss and use this to create your own music using percussion instruments
